# Half \& Half Granny Square 

## Square 3

Crochet in rounds with 2 colors $\boldsymbol{A}$ and $\boldsymbol{B}$. Turn your work at each round. There will be a RS and a WS. Always change colors on the WS. For changing colors on the WS, see "How to" panel on next page.

With A, make a MC.
Round 1 (RS). [A] Ch 3 (counts as a dc, photo 1), dc 2 , ch 2 , dc 3 closing the last st with B (photos 2-4). [B] Ch 2, dc 3, ch 2, dc 3, ch 1 (counts as a ch-2 sp), sl st in third-made ch to join (photos 5-6). (3 dc sts per side, 1 ch- 2 sp at each corner)


Round 2 (WS). [B] Ch 1, turn (photo 6), sl st in first corner sp, ch 3 (counts as a dc, photo 8). [Dc 2] in same ch-2 sp, ch 1, [dc 3, ch 2, dc 3] in next ch-2 sp, ch 1, [dc 3] in next ch-2 sp closing the last st with A (photo 9 and 10-12). [A] Ch 2, [dc 3] in same ch- 2 sp as last 3 sts, ch 1, [dc 3, ch 2, dc 3] in next ch-2 sp, ch 1, [dc 3] in next ch-2 sp, ch 1 (counts as a ch-2 sp, photo 13), sl st in third made ch. (6 dc sts and 1 ch-1 sp per side, 1 ch- 2 sp at each corner)


Round 3 (RS). [A] Ch 1, turn, sl st in first corner sp, ch 3 (counts as a dc, photo 14). [Dc 2] in same ch-2 sp, ch 1, [dc 3] in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, [dc 3, ch 2, dc 3] in next ch-2 sp, ch 1, [dc 3] in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, [dc 3] in next ch-2 sp closing the last st with B (photos 15-16). [B] Ch 2, [dc 3] in same ch-2 sp as last 3 sts, ch 1, [dc 3] in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, [dc 3, ch 2, dc 3] in next ch-2 sp, ch 1, [dc 3] in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, [dc 3] in initial corner sp, ch 1 (counts as a ch2 sp ), sl st in third made ch to join. (9 dc sts and 2 ch-1 sp per side, 1 ch-2 sp at each corner)

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## How to Change Color on the WS

- Change color with the last "yo, pull through 2" of the last dc in the current color or working yarn (in this example, color $B$ ).
- Hold your working yarn to the back (i.e. toward the RS) and the new color to the front (i.e. toward the WS, photo 10);
- Yo with the new color (in this example, color A) and pull through both loops on your hook (photo 11). The new color is now your working yarn.
- Pull the non-working yarn (i.e. the old color) to the right of your work if you are right-handed (photo 12) or to the left of your work if you are left-handed.
- Then, continue to crochet your granny square using your new working yarn.



Round 4 (WS). [B] Ch 1, turn, sl st in first corner sp, ch 3 (counts as a dc). [Dc 2] in same ch-2 sp, ch 1, *[dc 3] in next ch-1 sp, ch 1. Repeat from * twice. [Dc 3, ch 2, dc 3] in next ch-2 sp, ch 1, **[dc 3] in next ch-1 sp, ch 1. Repeat from ** twice. [Dc 3] in next ch-2 sp closing the last st with A. [A] Ch 2, [dc 3] in same ch-2 sp as last 3 sts, ch $1, \approx[\mathrm{dc} 3]$ in next ch-1 sp, ch 1. Repeat from $\approx$ twice. [Dc 3, ch 2, dc 3] in next ch-2 sp, ch 1, $\approx \approx[\mathrm{dc} 3]$ in next ch1 sp, ch 1 . Repeat from $\approx \approx$ twice. [Dc 3] in next ch2 sp , ch 1 (counts as a ch-2 sp), sl st in third made ch to join. ( 12 dc sts and $3 \mathrm{ch}-1$ sp per side, $1 \mathrm{ch}-2 \mathrm{sp}$ at each corner)

Round 5 (RS). [A] Ch 1, turn, sl st in first corner sp, ch 3 (counts as a dc). [Dc 2] in same ch-2 sp, ch 1, * [dc 3] in next ch-1 sp, ch 1. Repeat from * 3 times. [Dc 3, ch 2, dc 3] in next ch-2 sp, ch 1, **[dc 3] in next ch-1 sp, ch 1. Repeat from ** $\mathbf{3}$ times. [Dc 3] in next ch-2 sp closing the last st with B . $[\mathbf{B}] \mathrm{Ch} 2$, [dc 3] in same ch-2 sp as last 3 sts, ch 1, $\approx[\mathrm{dc} 3$ ] in next ch-1 sp, ch 1. Repeat from $\approx 3$ times. [Dc 3, ch 2, dc 3] in next ch-2 sp, ch 1, $\approx \approx[\mathrm{dc} 3$ 3] in next ch-1 sp, ch 1. Repeat from $\approx \approx 3$ times. [Dc 3] in next ch-

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2 sp, ch 1 (counts as a ch-2 sp), sl st in third made ch to join. ( 15 dc sts and 4 ch-1 sp per side, 1 ch- 2 sp at each corner)

Round 6 (WS). [B] Ch 1, turn, sl st in first corner sp, ch 3 (counts as a dc). [Dc 2] in same ch-2 sp, ch 1, *[dc 3] in next ch-1 sp, ch 1. Repeat from * 4 times. [Dc 3, ch 2, dc 3] in next ch-2 sp, ch 1, **[dc 3] in next ch-1 sp, ch 1. Repeat from ** 4 times. [Dc 3] in next ch-2 sp closing the last st with A. [A] Ch 2, [dc 3] in same ch-2 sp as last 3 sts, ch $1, \approx[\mathrm{dc}$ 3 ] in next ch-1 sp, ch 1 . Repeat from $\approx 4$ times. [Dc 3, ch 2, dc 3] in next ch-2 sp, ch 1, $\approx \approx[\mathrm{dc} 3$ 3] in next ch-1 sp, ch 1. Repeat from $\approx \approx 4$ times. [Dc 3] in next ch-2 sp, ch 1 (counts as a ch-2 sp), sl st in third made ch to join. ( 18 dc sts and $5 \mathrm{ch}-1$ sp per side, 1 ch-2 sp at each corner)

Round 7 (RS). [A] Ch 1, turn, sl st in first corner sp, ch 3 (counts as a dc). [Dc 2] in same ch-2 sp, ch 1, * [dc 3] in next ch-1 sp, ch 1. Repeat from * 5 times. [Dc 3, ch 2, dc 3] in next ch-2 sp, ch 1, **[dc 3] in next ch-1 sp, ch 1. Repeat from ** 5 times. [Dc 3] in next ch-2 sp closing the last st with B. [B] Ch 2, [dc 3] in same ch-2 sp as last 3 sts, ch $1, \approx[d c 3]$ in next ch-1 sp, ch 1 . Repeat from $\approx 5$ times. [Dc 3 , ch 2, dc 3] in next ch-2 sp, ch 1, $\approx \approx[\mathrm{dc} 3]$ in next ch-1 sp , ch 1 . Repeat from $\approx \approx \mathbf{5}$ times. [Dc 3] in next ch2 sp , ch 1 (counts as a ch-2 sp), sl st in third made ch to join. ( 21 dc sts and $6 \mathrm{ch}-1$ sp per side, $1 \mathrm{ch}-2 \mathrm{sp}$ at each corner)

Round 8 (WS). [B] Ch 1, turn, sl st in first corner sp, ch 3 (counts as adc). [Dc 2] in same ch-2 sp, ch 1, *[dc 3] in next ch-1 sp, ch 1. Repeat from * 6 times. [Dc 3, ch 2, dc 3] in next ch-2 sp, ch 1, **[dc 3] in next ch- 1 sp , ch 1. Repeat from ** 6 times. [Dc 3] in next ch-2 sp closing the last st with A. [A] Ch 2, [dc 3] in same ch-2 sp as last 3 sts, ch 1 , $\approx[\mathrm{dc}$ 3 ] in next ch-1 sp, ch 1 . Repeat from $\approx 6$ times. [Dc 3, ch 2, dc 3] in next ch-2 sp, ch 1, $\approx \approx[\mathrm{dc} 3$ 3] in next ch-1 sp, ch 1. Repeat from $\approx \approx 6$ times. [Dc 3] in next ch-2 sp, ch 1 (counts as a ch-2 sp), sl st in third made ch to join. ( 24 dc sts and $7 \mathrm{ch}-1$ sp per side, 1 ch-2 sp at each corner)


Round 9 (RS). [A] Ch 1, turn, sl st in first corner sp, ch 3 (counts as adc). [Dc 2] in same ch-2 sp, ch 1, * [dc 3] in next ch-1 sp, ch 1. Repeat from * 7 times. [Dc 3, ch 2, dc 3] in next ch-2 sp, ch 1, **[dc 3] in next ch-1 sp, ch 1. Repeat from ** 7 times. [Dc 3] in next ch-2 sp closing the last st with B. [B] Ch 2, [dc 3] in same ch-2 sp as last 3 sts, ch $1, \approx[d c 3]$ in next ch-1 sp, ch 1. Repeat from $\approx 7$ times. [Dc 3, ch 2, dc 3] in next ch-2 sp, ch 1, $\approx \approx[\mathrm{dc} 3]$ in next ch-1 sp, ch 1 . Repeat from $\approx \approx 7$ times. [Dc 3] in next ch2 sp , ch 1 (counts as a ch-2 sp), sl st in third made ch to join. ( 27 dc sts and 8 ch-1 sp per side, $1 \mathrm{ch}-2 \mathrm{sp}$ at each corner)

Round $\mathbf{1 0}$ (WS). [B] Ch 1, turn, sl st in first corner sp, ch 3 (counts as a dc). [Dc 2] in same ch-2 sp, ch 1, *[dc 3] in next ch-1 sp, ch 1. Repeat from * 8 times. [Dc 3, ch 2, dc 3] in next ch-2 sp, ch 1, **[dc 3] in next ch-1 sp, ch 1. Repeat from ** 8 times. [Dc 3] in next ch-2 sp closing the last st with A. [A] Ch 2, [dc 3] in same ch-2 sp as last 3 sts, ch 1, $\approx[\mathrm{dc}$ 3 ] in next ch-1 sp, ch 1 . Repeat from $\approx 8$ times. [Dc 3, ch 2, dc 3] in next ch-2 sp, ch 1, $\approx \approx[\mathrm{dc} 3$ 3] in next ch-1 sp, ch 1. Repeat from $\approx \approx \mathbf{8}$ times. [Dc 3] in next ch-2 sp, ch 1 (counts as a ch-2 sp), sl st in third made ch to join. ( 30 dc sts and 9 ch-1 sp per side, 1 ch-2 sp at each corner)

Fasten off and weave in all your ends
